Chapter 107.

Resolve in favor of economy in the public expenditures.

Resolved, That in view of the present depressed condition of all the industries of the state, and of the burdens upon the people, it is the duty of this legislature carefully to examine the nature and extent of every public expenditure, and to reduce every appropriation where it may be done without injury to the public interest.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey, by deed, to Leonora A. Patterson, widow of Herman V. Patterson, lot number four in the fourth range of lots situate in the east half of township number two, range five, west from the east line of the state.
