Chapter 114.

CHAP. 114.

Resolve in aid of Sola Coly.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of one hundred dollars in aid of Sola Coly, member of the Penobscot tribe of Indians, on account of loss by fire, to be paid to said Sola Coly by the agent of said tribe.

Chapter 115.

Resolves in relation to Compulsory Pilotage.

WHEREAS, The exacting of compulsory pilotage fees, where no pilotage service is requested or required, is contrary to natural justice, and imposes an onerous and useless burden on the navigation interests of the State of Maine: therefore,

Compulsory pilotage, in relation to.

Resolved, That the congress of the United States is requested to prohibit by law the exaction of compulsory pilotage in the ports of the United States.

Resolved further, That copies of this resolve be sent by the Secretary of State to the senators and representatives from this state in congress.

Chapter 116.

Resolve authorizing the State Treasurer to procure a Fire and Burglar Proof Safe.

Resolved, The state treasurer be, and is hereby authorized to procure a fire and burglar proof safe, for the use of the treasury department, at an expense not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars.

Chapter 117.

Resolve refunding a part of State Tax of Perkins Plantation.

Resolved, That the treasurer of state be, and is hereby authorized and directed to refund one hundred and forty-four dollars and twenty-five cents of the state tax assessed and collected of Perkins plantation, in the county of Franklin, in the years eighteen hundred and seventy-one, two, three and four.
