Resolve in favor of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state treasury to the chairman of the committee on agriculture, the sum of sixty dollars, in payment of expenses of said committee in visiting the College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts, pursuant to an order of the legislature.

Chapter 126.

Resolve authorizing the Secretary of State to purchase certain Reports.

Secretary of state
authorized to pur-
chase reports.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be, and is hereby authorized to purchase, for the use of the state, of the present publishers of the Maine reports, fifty volumes each of the Maine reports, from volume four to volume nine, both inclusive, at a price, not exceeding three dollars per volume. Said reports are to be annotated in a style similar to volumes one, two and three, already purchased by the state.

Chapter 127.

Resolve in favor of the Railroad Commissioners.

Resolved, That the governor and council be, and they are hereby authorized to audit the claim of the railroad commissioners against the state for services rendered upon the Portland and Oxford Central railroad, upon applications for injunctions against said road, and to pay so much of the same as they find equitably due.
