Chapter 143.

Rssolve in favor of James G. Griffin.

James G. Griffin, in favor of. Resolved, That the land agent be and is hereby authorized to convey by deed, the north half of section seventy-nine, in Mapleton plantation, to James G. Griffin, waiving further settling duties.

Approved February 18, 1876.

Chapter 144.

Resolve in favor of Caleb Sherman.

Caleb Sherman, in favor of. Resolved, That the land agent be and is hereby authorized to convey, by deed, lot numbered thirty-one, in township number five, range three, now Oakfield plantation, to Caleb Sherman, waiving further settling duties.

Chapter 145.

Resolve in favor of Hiram B. Hersey, of Crystal plantation.

Hiram B. Hersey, in favor of.

Resolved, The land agent be and is hereby authorized to deed to Hiram B. Hersey, of Crystal plantation, the south half of section fifty, in Crystal plantation.

Approved February 18, 1876.

Chapter 146.

Resolve in favor of James M. Story.

James M. Story, in favor of. Resolved, That the land agent be hereby directed to convey to James M. Story, lot number fifty-six, in the town of Washburn, waiving further settling duties.
