Chapman pl., in favor of. CHAPMAN PL -COM. ON STATE PRISON.-FRENCHVILLE.

Chapter 161.

Resolve in favor of Chapman plantation.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of building road in Chapman plantation, Aroostook county, the same to be expended under the supervision of the county commissioners of Aroostook county.

Approved February 21, 1876.

Chapter 162.

Resolve in favor of the Joint Standing Committee on the State Prison.

Resolved, That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay to Abel Prescott the sum of seventy-one dollars and five cents, it being for expenses incurred by the committee visiting the state prison the third day of February, eighteen hundred and seventy-six.

Chapter 163.

Resolve in aid of building bridge over Gagnon stream, in the town of Frenchville.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury, to the treasurer of the town of Frenchville, the sum of two hundred dollars, whenever the county commissioners of Aroostook county shall certify to the state treasurer that said town of Frenchville has built a good and substantial bridge over Gagnon stream, in said town.

Chapter 164.

Resolve in aid of road in Frenchville.

Road in Frenchville, in aid of. Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of rendering the highway road, in the town of Frenchville, safe and passable, at the point where the same runs between a high ledge of rocks and the St. John river; said sum to be paid to the treasurer of said town, when the county commissioners of Aroostook county shall certify
