# STATE OF MAINE.

1877.

An act to amend section eight of chapter seventeen of the Revised Statutes, relating to misances.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section eight of chapter seventeen of the revised statutes is Sec. 8, ch. 17, R. S., amended. hereby amended, by adding after the words "any valuable building," in the third line thereof, the words 'not owned by such person or his lessor, which was,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'SECT. 8. If a person carries on the business of manu- when buildings facturing gunpowder, or of mixing or grinding the compo- of gunpowder shall be deemed sition therefor, in any building within eighty rods of any nuisances. valuable building not owned by such person or his lessor, which was erected when such business was commenced, the former building shall be deemed a public nuisance; and such person may be prosecuted accordingly.'
