Chapter 219.**CHAP. 219**

An act to amend section eight of chapter seventeen of the Revised Statutes, relating to nuisances.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section eight of chapter seventeen of the revised statutes is hereby amended, by adding after the words "any valuable building," in the third line thereof, the words 'not owned by such person or his lessor, which was,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows :

Sec. 8, ch. 17,
R. S., amended.

'SECT. 8. If a person carries on the business of manufacturing gunpowder, or of mixing or grinding the composition therefor, in any building within eighty rods of any valuable building not owned by such person or his lessor, which was erected when such business was commenced, the former building shall be deemed a public nuisance ; and such person may be prosecuted accordingly.'

When buildings
for manufacture
of gunpowder
shall be deemed
nuisances.
