Chapter 322.

An act to amend an act, entitled "an act to incorporate the Maine State Pure Blood Jersey Stock Association."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter 323.

An act to amend the charter of the Ponobscot Log Driving Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Chapter four hundred and seven, of the special Ch. 407, special laws of 1846, laws of the year eighteen hundred and forty-six, entitled "an act to incorporate the Penobscot Log Driving Company," is hereby amended, by striking out from the fifth section thereof, the following sentence, viz: "And it shall be the duty of
