Chapter 326.

An act additional, relative to the Orchard Beach Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Directors may determine in regard to operating their railroad.

The Orchard Beach Railroad Company, or their directors, may, from time to time, determine what parts of their railroad they desire to operate, and at what portions of the year they desire to so operate the same, and shall not be holden to operate any part thereof, or at any portion of the year, except as they may determine, as aforesaid.

Chapter 327.

An act to make valid certain doings of the inhabitants of Bridgton Centre Village Corporation in the town of Bridgton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Doings of Bridgton Centre Village Corporation made valid.

SECT. 1. The doings of the inhabitants of Bridgton Centre Village Corporation in the town of Bridgton, done at its respective meetings, on the sixteenth day of January, twentieth day of April, fifth day of May, twentieth day of May, twenty-sixth day of May, ninth day of June, twenty-fourth day of June, ninth day of July, twenty-second day of July, fifth day of August, and nineteenth day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, in reorganizing said corporation, and in raising and assessing money for the purposes of said corporation, are hereby made valid and legal.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
