#### Chapter 351.

Снар. 351

An act additional to "an act to incorporate the city of Rockland."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whenever the city council of the city of Rockland shall determine, by vote, to pave any street or way, or any portion thereof, in said city, with stones or other pavement, it shall be lawful for said city council to assess the lots or parcels of land adjacent to and bounded on such street or way, in such proportion as in their opinion such lots or parcels of land are benefited or made more valuable by such Provided, however, that the whole assessment, Proviso. so made on any lot or parcel of land, shall, in no case, exceed one-third part of the cost of said pavement adjacent to said lot or parcel of land.

All of the rights, powers and duties now pro- Rights, powers and duties, how vided in said act to incorporate the city of Rockland, and applied. amendments thereto, relating to laying out, widening or altering any street or way, shall apply to assessments made and provided for in section one of this act.

#### Chapter 352.

An act to authorize the Second Baptist Society of Gorham to sell and convey all of its personal and real estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The Second Baptist Society of Gorham is here- Second Baptist Society of Gorham by empowered to sell and convey all of its personal and real estate.

Frederick Gilkey, of Gorham, member of said Parish meeting, parish, is hereby authorized and empowered to call a meeting of all parties interested in the affairs of said parish, at the meeting house owned by said society. Said meeting is hereby authorized to appoint a suitable person to sell and convey the property of said parish, and settle up the affairs of said parish; notice of the meeting shall be posted up in two conspicuous places in said town of Gorham, one week at least before said meeting.
