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County taxes collected in eighteen hundred and seventy-six, nine thousand sixteen dollars and ninety-seven cents, \$9,016 97

Amounting to eleven hundred ninety-nine thousand, eight hundred fifty-seven dollars and seventy-three cents, \$1,199,857 73

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 385.

An act to change and fix the limits of the town of Haynesville.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The limits of the town of Haynesville, as defined by chapter two hundred and ninety-three of the special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, are hereby so changed that the north line of said town shall be the north line of township number nine, Greenwood's survey, extended westerly to the east line of township number three, range three. Limits of town of Haynesville, changed.

SECT. 2. All arrears of taxes which have been assessed within the limits of said town, as incorporated by the act aforesaid, shall be paid to the collector's of said town. Taxes, to whom paid.

SECT. 3. Said town shall be entitled to the benefits of all stumpage, or timber cut since the act of incorporation of said town, on the reserved lands. Town entitled to stumpage.

### Chapter 386.

An act to incorporate the Bath Driving Park.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. John H. Kimball, George H. Nichols, William C. Duncan, E. B. Mayberry, J. A. McLellan, Franklin Reed, P. O. Rogers, H. A. Huse, C. F. Peterson, W. T. Donnell, S. S. Jordan, Jere Shannon, all of the county of Sagadahoc, Corporators.
