the towns of Wayne and Leeds, for the term of twenty years ; **CHAP. 388**
provided, that if the said Cunningham, his associates and assigns, shall neglect, for the term of one year, to navigate the said pond and river by steam, this act shall be void. Proviso.

SECT. 2. Said Cunningham, his associates and assigns, are hereby vested with all the powers, duties and privileges usually granted to such corporations. Powers, duties and privileges.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 388.

An act to change the name of the town of Lyndon to Caribou.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The name of the town of Lyndon, in Aroostook county, is hereby changed to Caribou. Town of Lyndon, name changed to Caribou.

Chapter 389.

An act to amend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the East Oxford Agricultural Society," approved February twenty-eight, in the year our Lord eighteen hundred and sixty-one.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Section three of an act entitled, "an act to incorporate the East Oxford Agricultural Society," is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words, viz : 'including the right to assess upon and collect from its members such sums as are necessary, at any time, to liquidate its indebtedness ; *provided*, a majority of the members present at any regular meeting duly called for such purpose, shall so vote ;' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows : Act amended.

SECT. 3. This society shall have all the powers and privileges and be subject to all the liabilities and restrictions usually granted to and imposed upon similar societies ; including the right to assess upon and collect from its members such sums as are necessary, at any time, to liquidate its Powers, privileges and liabilities.

CHAP. 390 indebtedness; provided, a majority of the members present at any regular meeting duly called for such purpose, shall so vote.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 390.

AN ACT for the assessment of a State Tax for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, amounting to the sum of six hundred seventy-five thousand one hundred seventy-three dollars and fifty-three cents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

State tax.

SECTION 1. That each city, town, plantation, or any other place hereinafter named within this State, shall be assessed and pay the several sums with which they respectively stand charged in the following lists; the same being in addition to the poll tax of one cent on each poll, a tax of three mills on the dollar of the present valuation, for the current disbursements of the treasury, and for the school mill fund established by an act approved February twenty-seventh, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, and for the sinking fund established by an act approved March seventh, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight.
