Chapter 398.

An act authorizing the city of Lewiston to loan the credit of the city for the purpose of introducing pure water into the city.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The city of Lewiston is hereby authorized to loan its credit for a sum not exceeding six hundred thousand dollars, for the purpose of introducing pure water into the said city, and make all necessary arrangements therefor, and issue the bonds of said city in payment therefor, payable at such times as said city may determine.

City of Lewiston authorized to loan credit to introduce pure water into the city.

Chapter 399.

An act to provide in part for the Expenditures of Government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. In order to provide for the several acts and resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment of money from the treasury, and also, to provide for the necessary expenditures of government for the current fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury, and the governor, with the advice and consent of the council, is hereby authorized, at any time prior to the first day of January next, to draw his warrant on the treasury for the same :
