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Chapter 217.

Resolve authorizing the removal of the colors presented to the Seventeenth Regiment of Maine Volunteers by the merchants of Portland.

Resolved, That the adjutant general be authorized to restore to the association of the seventeenth regiment of Maine volunteers a stand of colors which was presented to said regiment by the merchants of Portland and others, and which was deposited with the state at the close of the war.

Chapter 218.

Resolve in favor of Albion W. Stratton.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and is hereby authorized Albion W. Stratto convey, by deed, to Albion W. Stratton, lot numbered fourteen, section thirteen, in the town of Washburn, on payment of thirty-five cents per acre, in cash.

Resolve authorizing the Land Agent to convey by deed, to John Estes a lot of land.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and is hereby authorized John Estes, in to convey by deed, lot numbered four, in Oakfield plantation. to John Estes, waiving further settling duties.

Chapter 220.

Resolve in favor of Jessie Sutherland.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and is hereby authorized Jessie Sutherland to convey to Jessie Sutherland, lot of land numbered two, section twenty, in township G, range two, in the county of Aroostook, on the payment of the sum of sixty-eight dollars in cash.
