Chapter 225.

CHAP. 225

Resolve in favor of David Dudley.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and is hereby authorized to convey to David Dudley, lot number thirteen, in township number eleven, range three, west from the east line of the state, waiving further settling duties.

Resolve in favor of Isaac Varney.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and is hereby authorized to convey to Isaac Varney, lot numbered twenty-one, in township thirteen, range four, county of Aroostook, waiving further settling duties.

Chapter 227.

Resolves in relation to the binding of the Acts and Resolves of this State.

Resolved, That the special or private acts and resolves passed since eighteen hundred and seventy-four shall constitute the thirteenth volume of each, and that the public acts passed since eighteen hundred and seventy-four shall constitute a volume.

Resolved, That the secretary of state shall cause a title page, table of contents and general index to be prepared for each volume, and that he cause the said acts and resolves to be substantially bound and properly lettered, for the use of the executive and legislative departments of the government.
