CHAP. 244

Chapter 244.

Resolve in favor of Roads passing through the Indian Township, in Washington county.

Roads in Indian township, in favor of.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be appropriated, to be expended on that part of the Houlton and Baring road which lies in the Indian township; also that the sum of two hundred dollars be appropriated, to be expended on the road leading from the Houlton and Baring road, in said Indian township, to Grand Lake stream; said sums to be expended under the supervision of the governor and council.

Chapter 245.

Resolve in favor of Swedish settlers.

Swedish settlers, in favor of.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he is hereby authorized to convey to each Swedish settler who is not now accommodated with a sufficient number of acres of cultivable land for a farm, an additional quantity, not exceeding one lot, without the requirement of settling duties thereon, for the sum of thirty-five cents per acre, payable in road labor in one and two years.

Chapter 246.

Resolve in favor of the Joint Standing Committee on State Prison.

Committee on state prison, in favor of.

Resolved, That the treasurer of state is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the chairman of the joint standing committee on state prison, the sum of one hundred fifty-six dollars and eighty cents, it being for expenses incurred by the committee visiting the state prison, the twenty-fifth day of January, eighteen hundred and seventy-seven.
