CHAP. 249**Chapter 249.**

Resolve in favor of C. S. Hobbs, of Norway.

C. S. Hobbs, in favor of.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and he is hereby authorized to convey, by deed, to C. S. Hobbs, of Norway, an undivided half of lot numbered twenty-four, in township number seventeen, range seven, according to the survey and plan of said township made by John S. Webber, waiving further settling duties; and also to pay to said Hobbs the sum of twenty-two dollars and fifty cents, it being the amount paid by him for the undivided half of said lot, the fee of which is not in the state.

Chapter 250.

Resolve for the appointment of a commission to revise the militia laws.

Commission to revise militia laws, for appointment of.

Resolved, That the governor be requested, in his discretion, to appoint a commission consisting of three persons, whose duty it shall be, without expense to the state, other than necessary expenses actually incurred, to revise, amend, or add to the laws relating to the militia, as they in their judgment believe to be for the best interests of the state, and report the same to the next legislature.

Chapter 251.

Resolve in favor of the Joint Standing Committee on Financial Affairs.

Committee on financial affairs, in favor of.

Resolved, That the treasurer of state be and hereby is authorized and directed to pay to Benjamin F. Sturgis, the sum of twenty-three dollars, it being for expenses incurred by the joint standing committee on financial affairs, in visiting the Maine general hospital, the thirty-first day of January, eighteen hundred seventy-seven.
