### Chapter 259.

Resolve in favor of Charles W. Porter.

Resolved, That when Charles W. Porter shall have shown Charles W. Porter shown to the land agent that he is the lawful holder of the land certificate of lot number ninety-five, in township I, range two, west from the east line of the state, and shall have paid the balance of road labor due on said lot, at the rate of fifty cents per acre, the land agent be and he is hereby authorized to convey to him said lot, waiving all further settling duties.
