CHAP. 261**Chapter 261.**

Resolve in favor of Elisha W. Shaw, Franklin R. Webber and Byron Porter.

Elisha W. Shaw,
et. als., in favor
of.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and he is hereby authorized to refund to Elisha W. Shaw, Franklin R. Webber and Byron Porter, ninety-nine dollars and twenty cents, with interest from the twentieth day of October, eighteen hundred and seventy-five, it being for money paid by them to the state, for land in the town of Ripley, the title to which has proved defective; *provided* said Shaw, Webber and Porter shall first re-convey to the state all their right, title and interest in said land.

Chapter 262.

Resolve providing for payment of certain rents, now in suit, to the Agent of the Penobscot tribe of Indians.

Agent of Penobscot
Indians, for
payment of cer-
tain rents to.

Resolved, That the governor and council be, and hereby are authorized to draw their warrants on the treasurer, from time to time, in favor of the agent of the Penobscot tribe of Indians, for any and all sums collected and paid into the treasury upon suits now pending in the supreme judicial court, in the county of Penobscot, to recover from the several defendants therein, the unpaid rents due in eighteen hundred and seventy-six, upon leases given by said agent to several lessees of the shores of certain islands in the Penobscot river, said sums to be disbursed by said agent according to laws now in force.

Chapter 263.

Resolve repealing chapter one hundred and seventy-five of the resolves of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, relating to claims of settlers on proprietors' lands.

Ch. 176, resolves
of 1876, repealed.

Resolved, That chapter one hundred and seventy-five of resolves of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, entitled "Resolve relating to claims of settlers on proprietors' lands," be, and is hereby repealed.
