**Chapter 264.**

CHAP. 264

Resolve in favor of the Western Normal School.

*Resolved*, That there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars for the use of the western normal school, at Farmington; two hundred and fifty dollars for completing the slating of the school building, three hundred dollars for furniture for the main school room.

**Chapter 265.**

Resolve providing for the annual encampment of the Maine volunteer militia.

*Resolved*, That the sum of six thousand dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose and to defray the expenses of an annual encampment of the Maine volunteer militia, under the direction of the governor and council.

Annual encampment of militia, appropriation for.

Approved February 9, 1877.

**Chapter 266.**

Resolves relating to salary of clerk of Superintendent of Schools.

*Resolved*, That the yearly salary of the clerk of superintendent of schools be twelve hundred dollars.

Clerk of superintendent of schools, salary of.

*Resolved*, That all resolves and parts of resolves inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

**Chapter 267.**

Resolve in favor of the Military and Naval Asylum at Bath.

*Resolved*, That the sum of eight thousand dollars be, and hereby is appropriated for the use of the military and naval asylum at Bath; and that the further sum of five hundred dollars be, and is hereby appropriated, to be expended under the direction of the trustees of the asylum for the building of cisterns or a reservoir.
