Chapter 11.

An act to amend section twelve of chapter one hundred and thirty-three of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, relating to the Jail System of the State.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sec. 12, ch. 133, public laws 1873, amended.

Section twelve of chapter one hundred and thirty-three of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Deduction of sentence for good conduct. 'Sect. 12. The keeper of the jail in the several counties shall keep a record of the conduct of each convict, and for every month it appears by such record that such convict has faithfully observed all the rules and requirements of the prison, such convict shall be entitled to a deduction from his sentence according to and not exceeding the following rate and proportion: for a convict under sentence for six months and less than one year, two days for each month of good conduct; for one year and over, three days per month; and for every day any convict shall be punished for disobedience of the rules of said jail, a record thereof shall be made and two days deducted therefor from any commutations to which he may be entitled.'

Chapter 12.

An act to abolish the August Term of the Supreme Judicial Court in the county of Konnebec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sec. 17, ch. 77, R. S., amended. SECT. 1. Section seventeen, chapter seventy-seven of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the words "in the county of Kennebec, at Augusta, on the first Tuesdays of March and August, and the third Tuesday of October," and inserting in place thereof the words 'in the county of Kennebec, at Augusta, on the first Tuesday of March and the third Tuesday of October.'
