RAILROAD COMPANIES .- WAYS ACROSS RAILROADS.

A town way so re-established and laid out shall CHAP. 42. SECT. 2. Re-established not be discontinued for five years thereafter. way not to be discontinued for five years.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 42.

An act additional to chapter nineteen of the Public Laws of the year one thousaud eight hundred and seventy-five, relating to the taxation of Railroad Companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Any railroad company which has heretofore Railroad comomitted to apply to the governor and council, under chapter nineteen of the public acts of the year one thousand eight abatement of valuation. hundred and seventy-five, for an abatement of valuation claimed to be excessive, and whose claim for such abatement is barred by the limitation contained in said chapter, is hereby permitted to apply in writing to the governor and council, at any time within sixty days from the approval of this act by the governor, for an abatement of the excess of valuation of said company for any previous year.

Any abatement made by the governor and Abatement to be SECT. 2. council under this act shall be of no effect, unless the railroad company shall pay the arrearages of taxes due into the paid. state treasury within four months after the adjudication of the governor and council.

Chapter 43.

An act to amend chapter two hundred and fourteen of the Public Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, entitled "an act relating to Ways across Railroads."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:
