CHAP. 23.

Chapter 23.

An act to confirm and make valid the doings of Union School District, composed of district number one in the town of Carthage, district number nineteen in the town of Wilton, in the county of Franklin, and district number twelve in the town of Dixfield, in the county of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Union school district in Carthage and Wilton, doings made valid.

SECT. 1. The doings of the meetings of the qualified voters of Union School District, composed of district number one in the town of Carthage, district number nineteen in the town of Wilton, in the county of Franklin, and of district number twelve in the town of Dixfield, in the county of Oxford, at a meeting held on the second day of March, eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, also at a meeting held on the thirteenth day of October, eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, and adjourned to the fifteenth day of said October, are hereby confirmed and made valid.

Municipal officers of Carthage, made valid.

SECT. 2. The acts and doings of the municipal officers of the town of Carthage, in assessing and directing the collection of the tax, in pursuance of the votes passed at said meetings, are hereby confirmed and made valid.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved February 6, 1878.

Chapter 24.

An act to make valid the doings of School District eighteen, in the town of Gorham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

School district No. 18, Gorham, doings made valid.

SECT. 1. The doings of school district number eighteen, in the town of Gorham, at a meeting of said district, held on the twenty-seventh day September, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, and all acts and doings of said district, at all subsequent meetings held by adjournment from said meeting, on the said twenty-seventh day of September, or otherwise, prior to the first day of January, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, are hereby made valid.
