SECT. 5. Any person named in this act may call the first meeting of said corporation for the purpose of organization, by giving written notice thereof to each of the other corporators, five days at least before said meeting.

### Chapter 37.

An act to facilitate the transfer to the United States of the title to the Antietam National Cemetery, in the State of Maryland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

That the State of Maryland be, and is hereby authorized to convey to the United States, all the right, title and interest of the State of Maine in and to the land occupied by the Antietam National Cemetery, in the county of Washington, in the said State of Maryland, and if the said State of Maryland shall have already made such transfer of title to the United States, the assent thereto of the State of Maine is hereby granted. The governor of this commonwealth is requested to transmit a copy of this act to the President of the United States, and to the governor of the State of Maryland.

### Chapter 38.

An act to change the name of Rufus Edwin Bubier.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The name of Rufus Edwin Bubier is hereby changed to Rufus Edwin Donnell.
