### Chapter 59.

An act to set off certain property from Oxford Village Fire Engine Corporation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
 in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The respective farms of Seth T. Holbrook, Prescott L. Pike, Thomas Scales, and Nehemiah Manson, all of Oxford, in the county of Oxford, are hereby set off from Oxford Village Fire Engine Corporation.

### Chapter 61.

An act to incorporate the Deer Isle and Sedgwick Steam Ferry Company.
