CHAP. 76. reasonable repair, and if said dams or either of them are not kept in good repair, logs and lumber passing over the same shall be free of toll.

When lumber shall pass free.

Approved February 19, 1873.

Chapter 76.

An act to prevent the throwing of edgings, sawdust and other refuse into the waters of the harbor of Wiscasset.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Throwing refuse into Wiscasset harbor, prohibited.

SECT. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to throw any buttings, edgings, sawdust, shavings, or other waste made in the sawing or manufacturing of lumber, into the waters of the harbor of Wiscasset, or to so place or pile the same upon the banks of said harbor or elsewhere that they shall be liable to fall or be washed into said harbor.

Penalty.

SECT. 2. If any person or persons shall violate the provisions of this act, he or they shall be subject to a penalty or fine of not more than twenty dollars, nor less than five dollars, for each violation of this act, upon complaint and conviction before any court of competent jurisdiction.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 77.

An act additional to an act entitled "an act to amend the charter of the city of Augusta," approved February fifteen, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Provisions of former act not to apply to certain officers.

SECT. 1. The provisions of an act entitled "An Act to amend the charter of the city of Augusta," approved February fifteen, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, shall not apply to the common council of said city elected for the current municipal year, ending on the sixteenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
