affect, the ice on said river or on any of its tributaries, under a penalty for each offense, if the quantity shall not exceed five cords, of not less than five nor more than twenty dollars; if the quantity cast or thrown in, or that shall fall or be washed in as aforesaid, at one or different times, shall exceed five cords in all, under a penalty of not less than twenty nor more than five hundred dollars.

CHAP. 81.

Penalties.

SECT. 2. All the penalties under the provisions of the foregoing section shall be recovered by complaint or indictment before any court having jurisdiction in like offenses.

Penalties, how recovered.

SECT. 3. If the offense or offenses forbidden in the first section of this act, shall be committed by any person or persons who may be in the employ of any mill owner or owners, mill occupant or occupants, such owner or owners, occupant or occupants, shall also be liable in the same penalties, recoverable in the same manner as hereinbefore provided.

Mill owners and occupants liable.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect on the first day of September, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight.

Chapter 81.

An act to amend section five of chapter three hundred and eighty-six of the Special Laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-three, entitled "an act to supply the cities of Lewiston and Auburn with pure water."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Section five of chapter three hundred and eighty-six of the special laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-three, entitled "an act to supply the cities of Lewiston and Auburn with pure water," is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 5, ch. 386, special laws 1873, amended.

SECT. 5. The water commissioners for the city of Lewiston may enter upon any land within said city for locating pipe-ways, aqueducts, drains, dams, locks, hydrants, reservoirs and road-ways, doing no unnecessary damage, and said city may take and hold the quantity of land necessary in the opinion of said water commissioners for any of the purposes above named; and within thirty days after determining the

quantity of land and the boundaries thereof to be taken and held, said city shall file in the registry of deeds for the county of Androscoggin a full description of the same, with the purposes for which it is taken, signed by the aforesaid water commissioners, and after filing said description and purposes, may enter upon, take and hold, the land included in said description, for the purposes designated therein, and may use any portion of the land so taken and held, with any materials thereon, in the erection of any structure, making any grade, filling, or embankment, the damages therefor to be assessed as provided in section six of the act herein referred to.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 82.

An act to change the name of the Malachite Mining Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Malachite Mining
Company, name
changed.

SECT. 1. The name of the Malachite Mining Company, heretofore incorporated under the provisions of chapter forty-eight of the revised statutes, as of Winterport, in the State of Maine, is hereby changed so that its legal name is and shall hereafter be the Malachite Mining Company of Colorado.

SECT. 2. All acts heretofore done, and all titles, conveyances, and transfers of property heretofore given by or given to said company in any place, and whether under the name of the Malachite Mining Company or the Malachite Mining Company of Colorado, are hereby confirmed and established.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
