Chapter 89.

CHAP. 89.

An act to authorize the Trustees of Gorham Seminary to convey the property of said corporation for the use and purposes of the Normal School established at Gorham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The trustees of Gorham Seminary are hereby authorized and empowered to make such conveyance, transfer and delivery of the property of said corporation, for the use and purposes of the normal school established in Gorham by act of the legislature, entitled "an act to establish an additional normal school," as are contemplated by said act and necessary to carry the same into effect.

Trustees of Gorham Seminary authorized to convey property.

Approved February 21, 1878.

Chapter 90.

An act to authorize the town of Gorham, or any of its school districts, to raise money for providing buildings for the Normal School established in said town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The town of Gorham, or any school district or school districts therein, may raise, by loan or otherwise, a sum of money not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars in the aggregate, for the purpose of providing, by repairing or erecting, suitable buildings for the use of the normal school established in said town by an act of the legislature of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "an act to establish an additional normal school," and the proper authorities may make such conveyance of said property to the state as is contemplated by said act.

Town of Gorham, or school districts, authorized to raise money for buildings for the use of normal school.

SECT. 2. The money which said town shall vote to raise for the purposes named in section one of this act, shall be assessed and collected as money raised for the support of common schools is assessed and collected. The money so voted by any school district or school districts in said town, shall be assessed and collected as is the money raised by school districts for the erection or repair of school houses ; and all money raised by virtue of this act shall be paid over to the treasurer of said town, who shall keep a separate
