Chapter 51.**CHAP. 51.**

Resolve in favor of the State Reform School.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is appropriated, the sum of thirteen thousand dollars for the use of the state reform school, to meet the current expenses of the ensuing year, and one thousand dollars for repairs.

Chapter 52.

Resolve in favor of Elbridge D. Crouse.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to Elbridge D. Crouse lot number ninety-six, in township number thirteen, range three, west from the east line of the state, waiving further settling duties.

Chapter 53.

Resolve in favor of township number twelve, range five, west from the east line of the state, known as Sheridan plantation.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized and directed to pay to the treasurer of state, the sum of three hundred and seventy-five dollars, being for money received by the state from the sale of the right to cut timber and grass on the reserved lands in township number twelve, range five, west from the east line of the state, known as Sheridan plantation, and said treasurer is hereby directed to credit the same in account with the school fund of said township.
