G., T. AND J. CARY .- SCHOOL LAWS .- INDUSTRIAL SCHOOL.

### Chapter 54.

Resolve in favor of George Cary, Theodore Cary and Jefferson Cary.

George, Theodore and Jefferson Cary, in favor of.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state treasury to George Cary, Theodore Cary and Jefferson Cary, the sum of two hundred twenty-one dollars and twenty cents, being onefifth part of the expense of making partition of lands in township number sixteen, range seven, west from the east line of the state, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-three.

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### Chapter 55.

Resolve in favor of compiling and printing school laws.

Resolved, That the superintendent of common schools be, and hereby is instructed and empowered to cause the laws of this state relating to common schools, to include the laws passed the present session relating to the same, to be compiled, and five thousand copies printed and distributed among the several cities, towns and plantations in this state, the whole cost not to exceed four hundred dollars.

Approved February 19, 1878.

### Chapter 56.

#### Resolve in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls.

*Resolved*, That the sum of five thousand dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated for the use of the Maine industrial school for girls at Hallowell, to meet the current expenses of the ensuing year, the same to be expended by the trustees of said school.

Approved February 19, 1878.
