#### Chapter 87.

CHAP. 87.

Resolves authorizing a Temporary Loan.

Resolved, That to provide for the wants of the treasury, the treasurer of state be and he hereby is authorized to pro- authorized to cure, on the faith of the state, if he shall deem it necessary, during the current year, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be needed.

Resolved, That the treasurer of state is hereby authorized to give notes in behalf of the state, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per centum per annum, and reimbursable at the pleasure of the state, after sixty days and within twelve months from the date hereof, for such portions of the loan hereby authorized as may be found necessary.

### Chapter 88.

Resolve for repairing bridge over Molunkus Stream, in Macwahoc Plantation.

Resolved, That the sum of seventy-five dollars be appro- Molunkus stream, priated for repairing the bridge over Molunkus stream, in bridge over. Macwahoc plantation, to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Aroostook county.

#### Chapter 89.

Resolve in favor of the Maine General Hospital.

Resolved, That the sum of five thousand dollars be and hospital, in favor hereby is appropriated towards defraying the expenses of the Maine general hospital, for the year ending December thirty-one, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight; and that the governor be and is hereby authorized to draw his warrant quarterly, commencing March thirty-one, for the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars, for the above purpose.
