Chapter 129.

Resolve in favor of the Joint Standing Committee on Reform School.

A. Hawes, in favor of. Resolved, That the treasurer of the state is hereby authorized and directed to pay A. Hawes, chairman of the joint standing committee on reform school, the sum of twenty-four dollars and seventy-five cents, the same being for expenses incurred by the committee visiting the reform school at Cape Elizabeth and the industrial school at Hallowell.

Approved February 25, 1879.

Chapter 130.

Resolve in favor of Lavinia P. Rollins.

Lavinia P. Rollins, in favor of.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to Lavinia P. Rollins, the north part of lot number seventy-three, in township D, range one, Aroostook county, waiving further settling duties.

Approved February 25, 1879.

Chapter 131.

Resolve in favor of the abatement of the State Tax on Washington Plantation.

Tax on Washington plantation abated.

Resolved, That the state tax assessed on Washington plantation, in Franklin county, for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, amounting to twenty dollars and fifty-three cents, be, and hereby is abated.
