Chapter 199.

An act authorizing Patrick McMannus to build a Dyke, or Dykes, on Duck Pond Creek.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

That Patrick McMannus, of Brunswick, in the county of Cumberland, is hereby authorized and empowered to construct a dyke, or dykes, on Duck Pond Creek in said Brunswick, to prevent the flowage of the waters of Casco Bay on land of aforesaid McMannus, subject to the laws of this State relating to flowage, or damage to parties thereby.

Dykes on Duck Pond Creek, construction authorized.

Approved February 7, 1880.

Chapter 200.

An act amendatory of and additional to "An Act to incorporate the Rumford Falls and Buckfield Railroad Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The act to incorporate the Rumford Falls and Buckfield Railroad Company, approved the third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, is hereby amended in the first section thereof, by inserting,
