Chapter 203.

CHAP. 203

An act to amend "An Act to incorporate the Portland Turnverein."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section two of chapter three hundred and sixty-two of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, is hereby amended, by striking out the word "five," in the second line of said section, and inserting, in place thereof, the word 'fifteen,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows :

Sec. 2, ch. 362,
special laws 1859,
amended.

'SECT. 2. Said corporation may take and hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars.'

Chapter 204.

An act to extend the time for the completion of the Bangor and Piscataquis Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The Bangor and Piscataquis Railroad Company shall have a further time of three years from January twenty-seven, eighteen hundred and eighty, within which to complete its line of railroad to Moosehead lake.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 205.

An act to amend "An Act to incorporate the Richardson Wharf Company," approved April two, eighteen hundred and fifty-six.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

That the act to incorporate the Richardson Wharf Company, approved April two, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, be, and the same is, amended by striking out in the second section of said act the words "one hundred and fifty thousand," and inserting, in place thereof, the words 'two hundred and
