SECT. 5. Any one of the corporators named in this act Chap. 234 may call the first meeting of this company, by mailing a First meeting, how called. written notice, postage paid, to each of the other corporators, seven days at least before the day of meeting, naming the time, place and purposes of such meeting. And at such meeting a president, secretary, treasurer and directors may officers and by-laws. be chosen, by-laws adopted, and any corporate business transacted.

Sect. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 234.

An act authorizing the location of a Way over the tide waters between Elwell's Point and Spruce Head Island, in South Thomaston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Authority is hereby granted for the location and establish- Location and ment of a way over tide waters, with suitable bridge, from way, authorized. the terminus of the town road, on Elwell's Point, in the town of South Thomaston, to Spruce Head Island, situated in South Thomaston aforesaid, a distance of about two hundred and thirty-seven feet at low water, and about three hundred and ninety-eight feet at high water, by the same proceedings, and in the same manner as would be required to lay out and establish such way if said waters were not tide waters.

Chapter 235.

An act to amend section two of chapter one hundred and sixty-four of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, concerning the Proprietors of Sheepscot River Bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Section two of chapter one hundred and sixty- Sec. 2. ch. 164. four of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and special laws 1862, amended. sixty-two is hereby amended, by striking out the word "eighteen," in the second line, and inserting instead thereof
