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## CHAP. 164

**Chapter 164.**

Resolve for the appointment of a Commission to revise the Militia Laws.

Commission to  
revise militia  
laws, appoint-  
ment of.

*Resolved*, That the governor be requested to appoint a commission, consisting of five officers, of the active and reserve militia, to revise, amend, or add to the laws relating to the militia, as they, in their judgment, believe to be for the best interests of the state, and report the same to the present legislature, forthwith. Said commission shall be no expense to the state, except in actual expenses incurred by same.

**Chapter 165.**

Resolve in favor of Lewy Mitchell, Representative of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.

Lewy Mitchell, in

*Resolved*, That there be paid from the state treasury, one hundred dollars, to Lewy Mitchell, for travel and attendance before the legislature, as representative of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians.

Approved February 16, 1880.

**Chapter 166.**

Resolve in favor of Lola Cola, Representative of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Lola Cola, in  
favor of.

*Resolved*, That there be paid from the state treasury, one hundred dollars, to Lola Cola, for travel and attendance before the legislature, as representative of the Penobscot tribe of Indians.

Approved February 16, 1880.

**Chapter 167.**

Resolve for an appropriation for the payment of liabilities incurred in the preservation and protection of the Public Property and Institutions of the State.

*Resolved*, That the sum of eighteen thousand dollars be, and is hereby appropriated, for the purpose of paying existing liabilities, incurred under the direction of governor Gar-
