Chapter 190.

Resolve in favor of the State Reform School.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the Reform school, sum of ten thousand five hundred dollars for the use of the state reform school, to pay the deficiency and to meet the current expenses of the ensuing year.

Chapter 191.

Resolve for the purchase of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be authorized to con- Maine state year tract for six hundred copies of the Maine State Year Book chase of. and Legislative Manual, at a cost not to exceed eight hundred.

Chap. 192 dollars, namely: one hundred copies octavo, suitable for binding with the documents, one copy to be delivered by the secretary of state, on or before the first day of May, to each officer and member of the legislature of eighteen hundred and eighty, and the balance to be delivered to the secretary of state, of which balance one copy shall by said secretary be delivered to each officer and member of the legislature of eighteen hundred and eighty-one, and the remainder to be delivered to the heads of the departments for their use.

Chapter 192.

Resolve laying a tax on the counties of the state.

County taxes.

Resolved, That the sums annexed to the counties in the following schedule are hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed, collected, and applied for the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same, and other purposes ordered by law, to wit: Androscoggin, twenty-eight thousand dollars; Aroostook, fourteen thousand dollars; Cumberland, fifty-five thousand dollars; Franklin, seven thousand dollars; Hancock, twelve thousand dollars; Knox, sixteen thousand dollars; Kennebec, thirty-eight thousand dollars; Lincoln, eight thousand dollars; Oxford, eleven thousand dollars; Penobscot, forty thousand dollars: Piscataguis, six thousand dollars; Sagadahoc, sixteen thousand five hundred dollars; Somerset, eleven thousand five hundred dollars; Washington, sixteen thousand dollars; Waldo, sixteen thousand dollars; York, eighteen thousand dollars.

Chapter 193.

Resolve concerning the transportation of certain books from the State Library.

State librarian to send books to town clerks.

Resolved, That the state librarian be and is hereby instructed to forward annually, by express or mail, to the clerks of the various towns and plantations in this state, all
