eighteen hundred and eighty, and eighteen hundred and eighty-one; said building to be completed during the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one. But not more than eighty-five per cent. of such funds or income shall be used in any one year. The cost of such building shall not exceed the sum of eighteen thousand dollars. Plans and specifications of said building shall be made by the trustees, and the materials, erection and completion of the building shall be done by contract or contracts, and the trustees shall superintend the work as it progresses. Chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the resolves of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine is hereby repealed.

Resolve in favor of the Female Orphan Asylum of Portland.
