**Chapter 203.**

Resolve in aid of the Maine General Hospital.

*Resolved*, That the sum of five thousand dollars be, and hereby is appropriated towards defraying the expenses of the Maine General Hospital, for the year ending December thirty-one, eighteen hundred and eighty; and that the governor be and hereby is authorized to draw his warrant quarterly, commencing March thirty-one, eighteen hundred and eighty, for the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars, for the above purpose.
