Chapter 225.

Resolve in favor of the Teachers of the Normal School at Gorham.

Teachers of the

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the payment of arrears of wages due to William J. Corthell and others, teachers in the Western Normal School at Gorham, for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-nine.

Chapter 226.

Resolve concerning the report of the committee to investigate the charges of attempted bribery of members of the House of Representatives.

Committee on
bribery, concern-
ing.

Resolved, That twenty-five hundred copies of the report of the select committee of the house, appointed by virtue of an order dated January twenty, eighteen hundred and eighty, to investigate certain charges of attempted bribery of members, together with the testimony accompanying it and the report of the minority, be printed, of which number fifteen hundred copies shall be for the use of the house of representatives; five hundred for the use of the senate; two hundred for the use of the governor and council, and two hundred for the use of the committee which has conducted the investigation; and that the sum of fifteen hundred dollars is hereby directed to be drawn from the general printing fund for that purpose.
