# 1881.

#### Chapter 30.

An act in relation to the times of holding sessions of the County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The county commissioners of the County of Washington, shall hold annual sessions at Machias, on the first Tuesdays of January and October, and at Calais on the fourth Tuesday of April.

SECT. 2. Chapter one hundred and ninety-one of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, is hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. So much of section six of chapter seventy-eight of the revised statutes and amendments thereto, as were in force at the time said chapter one hundred and ninety-one of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, took effect, except the provisions as to Washington county, are hereby revived.

Approved February 26, 1881.

### Chapter 31.

An act relating to Costs in actions of dower.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

In all actions of dower, when it appears to the court that there has been no refusal to set out dower, the costs accruing on the assignment of dower shall be apportioned according to the interests of the parties.

Approved February 26, 1881.

### Chapter 32.

An act additional to sections fourteen, fifteen, sixteen and eighteen of chapter twelve of the Revised Statutes, relating to Parishes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The word "person," in sections fourteen, fifteen, SECT. 1. sixteen and eighteen of chapter twelve of the revised statutes,
