Sect. 5. The first meeting of the corporation may be called by the person named in the first section of this act, First meeting, how called. by posting a written notice, by him signed, at any public place in said Auburn, at least five days previous to the day o' said meeting.

SECT. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved January 28, 1881.

Chapter 8.

An act additional to chapter two hundred and seventy-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-three, conferring certain powers on the city of Portland in relation to Evergreen Cemetery.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The city of Portland may ordain reasonable city of Portland by-laws and regulations for the government of Evergreen laws for government of evergreen cemetery, and shall have full power and authority to impose green cemetery. and enforce penalties for the breach thereof, and for the punishment of offenses committed in said cemetery.

SECT. 2. All by-laws and regulations heretofore ordained Former by-laws by said city of Portland for the government of Evergreen valid. cemetery are, and shall be valid and in force; and all penalties imposed under the same, and for the breach of the same, and for punishment of offenses committed in said cemetery, shall be enforced.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 9.

An act authorizing the county commissioners of the county of Washington to re-assess certain Taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:
