reduced to a sum sufficient, in the opinion of the directors of said company, to keep said dams, works and improvements in repair, and for protecting and preserving them. CHAP. 16.

SECT. 4. This act may be accepted by a vote of a majority of the directors of said company. Directors may accept act by majority vote.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 16.

An act to authorize the Little Androscoggin Water Power Company to increase its capital stock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The Little Androscoggin Water Power Company, organized in accordance with the provisions of chapter ninety-three of the laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy, are hereby authorized to increase its capital stock to a sum not exceeding one million dollars, to be fixed at any legal meeting of the stock holders of the company, called for that purpose, at which meeting the acceptance and adoption of this act by the company shall require a majority of two-thirds of the stock of the company. Little Androscoggin Water Power Co. authorized to increase capital stock.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 17.

An act to incorporate the Pejepsot Manufacturing Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Nathaniel W. Farwell, John W. Farwell and Nahum Morrill, their associates and successors are hereby created a body politic and corporate by the name of the Pejepsot Manufacturing Company, for the purpose of manufacturing wood, iron, cotton, wool and flax in the city of Lewiston or Auburn, with power, at some point within the Corporators.
