MAINE REPORTS-ELI GOSS-TOWN OF FRANKFORT.

Chapter 230.

Resolve authorizing the Secretary of State to purchase certain volumes of the Maine Reports.

Maine Reports, purchase of, in favor of. Resolved, That the secretary of state be, and he is hereby authorized to purchase for the use of the state, of McLellan, Mosher and Company, fifty of each of the Maine reports, volumes forty-three and forty-four, at a price not exceeding four dollars per volume.

Chapter 231.

Resolve in favor of Eli Goss of Portland.

Eli Goss, in favor of. Resolved, That there be paid to Eli Goss out of the treasury of this state, the sum of four dollars per month, from the first day of January, eighteen hundred and eightyfive, during his life, for injuries received while in the service of the state, this sum to be in addition to that now received by him.

Chapter 232.

Resolve in favor of the town of Frankfort.

Resolved, That there be paid by the treasurer of state, out of the school funds of the current year, to the town of Frankfort, the sum of sixty-eight dollars and sixty-four cents, it being a balance equitably due said town as its proportion of the school funds for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four.
