## PUBLIC LAWS

### INTOXICATING LIQUORS.

The treasurer of state is hereby authorized and Sect. 5. directed to cancel all state of Maine bonds now in the sinking fund, or such as may hereafter be purchased for the state, the interest thereon to cease at the time of purchase, and no moneys shall hereafter be paid to the fund for interest on bonds of this state. The bonds aforesaid shall be destroyed in the presence of the joint committee, appointed by the governor and council to examine the treasurer's accounts.

SECT. 6. The annual appropriation from taxation for the Annual approprincipal of the sinking fund provided for in section twentytwo, chapter two of the revised statutes, is hereby terminated.

SECT. 7. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this Inconsistent act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 8. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 44.

An Act to amend section nine, chapter three hundred and sixty-six of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five, relating to Intoxicating Liquors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section uine, chapter three hundred and sixty-six of the Sec. 9, ch. 306, public laws of hundred and eighty-five, is hereby 1885, amended. public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five, is hereby amended by striking out the word "all" in the fourth line of said section and inserting the word 'each,' and by changing the word "cases" in said line to 'case,' and by changing the word "indictments" to 'indictment,' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows :

'SECT. 9. It shall be the duty of the clerk of courts, within thirty days after the adjournment of any superior or supreme judicial court, to publish in some newspaper of the county, the disposition of each appealed case and indictment for violations of the laws regulating the use and sale of intoxicating liquors.'
