may deem expedient and necessary, not to exceed the sum of one hundred thousand dollars in addition to the amount of its present bonded debt, heretofore authorized, and to secure the same by a mortgage or deed of trust of the franchises, property and estate owned by or to be hereafter acquired by said corporation, but such mortgage shall not diminish the security of the bonds heretofore issued by said corporation remaining unpaid.

CHAP. 24

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 24.

An Act to amend chapter three hundred and seventeen of the Private Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, relating to Saint Croix Gas Light Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

That chapter three hundred and seventeen of the private laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six is hereby amended by adding thereto the following :

Ch. 317, Private Laws of 1876, amended.

SECT. 2. Said company is hereby authorized and empowered to manufacture and sell light, heat or motive power created by gas or electricity, or both, and to hold such real and personal property as may be necessary for said purpose, and to do and perform all things necessary for conducting said business.'

Chapter 25.

An Act to incorporate the Dover and Foxcroft Light and Heat Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. E. A. Thompson, J. B. Mayo, Willis E. Parsons, John F. Arnold, E. S. Favor, Joseph B. Peaks, J. A. Launder, H. M. Heath, Weston Lewis, J. S. Maxcy, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of the Dover and Foxcroft Light and Heat Company, and by that name shall have and enjoy all rights, privileges and powers necessary to effect the objects of their incorporation.
