#### Chapter 273.

An Act to amend an act entitled "An Act to correct the Taxation of certain Plantations."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The act entitled "An Act to correct the taxation of certain Act to correct taxation of certain Act to correct taxation of certain taxation taxatin taxation taxation taxation taxation taxation t plantations," approved February one, eighteen hundred and tampiant eighty-seven, is hereby amended, by adding at the end of the second section, the words 'and all moneys apportioned to the several plantations herein named, prior to the year eighteen hundred and eighty-six, on account of school and mill tax funds, are hereby withheld, and the treasurer of state is hereby authorized to cancel the same on his books.'

Chapter 274.

An Act to fix the salary of the Recorder of the Municipal Court for the city of Portland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The salary of the recorder of the municipal court Sect. 1. for the city of Portland shall be seventeen hundred dollars, which shall be in full of all services, including clerk hire, and it shall be the duty of said recorder to make and post all Portland, fixed. copies of libels and monitions in liquor cases.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

#### Chapter 275.

An Act to amend chapter one hundred and six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-one, relative to James A. Creighton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:
