### Chapter 85.

Resolve in favor of Bancroft Plantation.

Bancroft plantation, in favor of. Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated, to aid in repairing and building piers for the bridge over Mattawamkeag river, in Baucroft plantation, Aroostook county, to be expended under the direction of county commissioners of Aroostook county.

Approved March 11, 1887.

### Chapter 86.

Resolve in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls.

Industrial School, in favor of. Resolved, That there be, and is hereby appropriated from the funds in the state treasury, the sum of five thousand dollars, for the use of the Maine Industrial School for Girls, at Hallowell, to meet the current expenses for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven; and five thousand dollars to meet the current expenses for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight; and the sum additional of one thousand dollars, to aid in the erection of outbuildings and procuring a better supply of water.
