#### Снар. 179

### Chapter 179.

An Act to legalize the proceedings by which Highland Plantation was organized.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Proceedings of Highland plantation, legalized. The proceedings by which Highland plantation in Somerset county, was organized in February eighteen hundred and eighty-six, are hereby confirmed and the organization of said plantation is hereby declared legal and valid.

Approved March 10, 1891.

#### Chapter 180.

An Act to change the name of Sarah Elizabeth Wasgatt Jordan of Eden.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Name changed.

SECT. 1. The name of Sarah Elizabeth Wasgatt Jordan hereby changed to Sarah Elizabeth Wasgatt.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved March 10, 1891.

### Chapter 181.

An Act to change the name of William Ela of Fryeburg.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Name changed.

SECT. 1. The name of William Ela of Fryeburg is hereby changed to William Gammon.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved March 10, 1891.
