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CHAP. 210

ciala shall be completed and made to the city council at a meeting to be held on the third Mouday of February. And the city treasurer shall cause to be published in all the city papers issued during the week prior to the first Monday in March, an accurate summary of the reports of all officials receiving or disbursing moneys of the city, and a statement of the condition of the several appropriations.'

**Chapter 210.**

An Act to amend chapter two hundred and twenty-seven of the Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, being an act to incorporate the Pungustuk Water Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Sec. 8, ch. 227,  
Private Laws,  
1887, amended.

SECT. 1. Section eight of chapter two hundred and twenty-seven of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, incorporating the Pungustuk Water Company, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

Company, may  
issue bonds and  
mortgage prop-  
erty.

'SECT. 8. Said corporation may issue its bonds for the construction of its works, upon such rates and times as it may deem expedient, not exceeding fifty thousand dollars, and secure the same by a mortgage of the franchise and property of said company.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 211.**

An Act to amend section one of chapter five hundred and fourteen of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, entitled "An Act to set off part of Drew Plantation and annex the same to Reed Plantation."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Sec. 1, ch. 514,  
Private Laws of  
1889, amended.

SECT. 1. Section one, chapter five hundred and fourteen of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine is hereby amended, by adding thereto the following: 'Said part of said Drew plantation, annexed as above
